**ORDER**

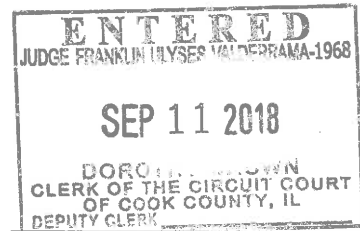
THIS MATTER coming before the Court for a status hearing, due notice given, the parties and intervenors present through counsel, the Court being fully advised in the premises, with counsel for Defendants having provided to the Court for *in camera* review the list of SKUs of certain Monster HDMI cables that were inadvertently omitted from the search for Class member email addresses that occurred earlier this year,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. Defendants shall provide the email addresses associated with the aforementioned list of SKUs to the Settlement Administrator on or before September 14, 2018.
2. The Settlement Administrator shall de-duplicate the email addresses and cross-reference the email addresses against the list of email addresses to whom an Email Notice was previously sent. On or before September 28, 2018, the Settlement Administrator shall send an Email Notice to those email addresses that previously were not sent an Email Notice. If there are any undeliverable Email Notices, then the Settlement Administrator shall send a physical postcard notice via first-class mail for those which Defendants have a U.S. postal address.
3. The Email Notice shall provide that these Settlement Class Members have until November 12, 2018 (45 days after Email Notice) to opt-out or object to the Settlement.
4. The Email Notice shall provide that these Settlement Class Members have until December 27, 2018 (45 days after the applicable opt-out and objection deadline) to submit a Claim Form.
5. Plaintiffs shall file a motion for final approval and fee petition on or before January 24, 2019

(28 days after the applicable Claims deadline).

6. The Final Fairness Hearing is set for February 7, 2019 (14 days after the filing of Plaintiffs' motion for final approval and fee petition), at 2:30 p.m.
7. The motion for final approval shall include a declaration from the Settlement Administrator identifying for *each* round of notice:
  - a. Number of emails sent;
  - b. Number of bouncebacks/mailed postcard notices sent;
  - c. Number of claims submitted and approved;
  - d. Number of requests for exclusion; and
  - e. Number of objections.
